Movie Party

Instructions: Host a movie party and show one of the Top 100 Films from the American Film Institute's list. Try to pick a Film that few people who are participating have seen. Invite members from film class; try to include as many Film 12s as you can as they will participate in the post video party Forum Discussion. Students from iFilm, Film 11 and interested friends may also attend.

After watching the film, Film 12 students (and interested students from iFilm and Film 11) should go to the Movie Party Discussion Forum and host a debate on the merits of the chosen film. Please keep the discussion organized to a single thread per movie. The discussion should include the following:

1. Why do you think the movie is included in the AFI's Top 100?
2. Does the movie deserve to belong in the Top 100 movies of all time? Why or why not? And, do you agree with where it is ranked (too high, too low)?
3. Would this film be in your top 100? Why or why not?
4. How does filmmaking differ today compared to when this movie was made?
5. Why do you think this movie is significant to film history?
